



SMALL BATHROOM SPACE OPTIMISATION CHECKLIST

1. STRUCTURAL STRUCTURAL & CAVITY AUDITS

- Stud Wall Cavities:**
Check for non-load-bearing partitions or false walls. Recessing toilet cisterns or creating built-in shower niches inside these voids reclaims critical storage inches without shrinking room dimensions.
- Doorway Swing Clearances:**
Assess the operational footprint of the entrance door. Identify if converting to an outward-opening layout or integrating a sliding pocket door frees up structural corner floor space.

2. VISUAL FOOTPRINT & ELEVATION TUNING

- Floating Sanitaryware Opportunities:**
Evaluate the feasibility of mounting the vanity cabinet and toilet directly to the wall framework. Keeping the floor fully visible creates a powerful illusion of continuous, expanded floor area.
- Vertical Scale Expansion:**
Identify unutilised vertical surfaces reaching up to the ceiling line. Plan layout structures for high-level custom shelving or tall, slender mirrored cabinetry to pull the sightline upward.

3. LUMINESCENCE & MATERIAL STRATEGY

- Natural Light & Reflection Fields:**
Map out cross-reflection potential. Position large-format mirrored finishes directly opposite window openings or feature tile displays to amplify bouncing ambient light levels.
- Frameless Enclosure Configurations:**
Review bulky shower framing elements. Plan for clear, minimalist frameless glass partition systems to visually erase distinct internal boundaries.
